

Bylaw Amendment Proposal - Presidential Term Limit
Submitted by the ICSA Nominating Committee

The current term limit in Article IX Section 3 of the ICSA Bylaws, states that:

“The President shall be limited to six consecutive terms, this provision effective with the term beginning July 1, 2016.”

This rule was created with the intent and expectation that a full time Executive Director would have been hired by 2021 at the latest. The timing would have allowed the ED to have an experienced president with whom to work and collaborate with for one calendar year. Unfortunately a global pandemic disrupted this plan. In order to maintain the intent with which this bylaw was written, the Nominating Committee proposes the following amendment to Article IX, Section 3 of the ICSA Bylaws:

The President shall be limited to six consecutive terms, this provision effective with the term beginning July 1, 2017.
