Two fleets of 18 boats, each with new sails, supplied by Fordham (Z420s) and University of Wisconsin (Z420s), will be used for the Women's and Coed Championships. With Chicago Yacht Club Jibs.

Facilities:

All pre-regatta registrations and check-ins will take place at the Chicago Yacht Club. A continental breakfast will be provided at the CYC the first morning of each event. Skippers' meetings will take place at the CYC. There is excellent viewing from the sailing venue where there will be a tent set up and bathroom facilities. Showers are available at Monroe Station..

Coaching:

Coach boats may be made available for Women's and Coed Dinghies, but racing will be easily viewed from the shore at Monroe Harbor.

Afterguard Regatta:

The Afterguard Regatta will be held in Sonars at Belmont Harbor on June 3.

Annual Meeting:

The ICSA Annual Meeting will be held in the Sailing Center at Belmont Harbor. Food will be provided by the CYC.

Housing Accommodations:

Numerous hotels and Bed and Breakfasts can be found throughout Chicago.

Transportation:

Chicago is served by two major airports. O'Hare is about 45 minutes from CYC-Belmont and one hour from CYC-Monroe. Midway is about one hour from CYC-Belmont and 45 minutes from CYC-Monroe. Vehicle rentals are available at the airport from all major companies. Chicago also has good public transportation that has stations at each airport and near each CYC location and the racing area.

Schedule Note:

Bike the Drive is Sunday, May 28, 2017. This means Lake Shore Drive will be closed to car traffic between Bryn Mawr Avenue and 59th Street from 5:30am until 11:00am. The midpoint start/finish is immediately across from CYC-Monroe. Competitors are advised to look up alternative routes to the sailing venue and allow for extra time that morning to handle traffic.
