

Eligibility/Selection Guidelines

The initial slate would be 18 teams divided among the conferences using a similar proportional structure as the former berth allocation system. Eligible teams would come only from ICSA Regional teams who are otherwise not selected for Coed's or Women's College Nationals, nor are they within the top CSR 36. *Current CSR list (not yet published for 2024)*

Conference selections to this championship will be made by the *conference commissioner; one coach, undergraduate president, vice president, and two additional undergraduates from student-led teams (one being a reserve member in case of recusal needs) after Weekend #7*, allowing all conferences to select from fall and spring results and the spring conference regattas that showcase Regional teams. Panelists whose teams are up for eligibility confirmation should be recused, and a replacement of the same qualification (undergraduate or graduate representative) should be brought in to affirm or challenge that team's eligibility. By Wednesday after Weekend #7, the selected teams shall be notified. Notification to selected teams will be made via the scheduling coordinator. Teams would have a turnaround time of two days to accept or decline a berth.

Should a team decline the berth, the empty berth would be offered to the next team eligible in that conference, following the ICSA scheduling guidelines.

Committee members who sail for, or coach a team up for consideration should recuse themselves

Spring 2025 Timeline

We realize conference championships will not necessarily have taken place however, due to the tight window for selection and travel arrangements, we would hope

		that conferences take into consideration their teams body of work to include the current CSR and other data from regattas.
March 26, 2025	Response Deadline*	Deadline for selected teams (and alternate teams) to accept or decline invitations in order for teams to make travel plans
March 31, 2025	Final Slate Deadline*	Conference selection committees email ICSA Scheduling Coordinator with which teams are taking that conferences berths

*Conferences may (and are encouraged to) select and notify invited teams and email ICSA Scheduling Coordinator earlier than these dates.

Berths

Determined by taking a proportion of the number of teams in a conference that competed in 2024-2025 as a proportion of the eighteen (18) boats available (aka: the *pre-CSR selection committee berth allocation formula* for Nationals). These numbers can change based on the Nationals formula in 2025. ***Allocations as of 3.5.2024 are below. These allocations may change when the updated CSR is published and the list of R schools has been updated.***

Using average CSR scores for Regional Teams in each conference not in the top 36 as of 2.24 to influence ‘ties’ to determine berths. The results in column right are the berth allocations for the Regional Teams Championship.

Selection Process

Conference Committees shall select teams via their conference’s assembled selection committee. Conference Committees may select only Regional teams that are not in the top 36 of the CSR

following the conclusion of Spring Weekend #7. Should all regional teams in a conference outside the top 36 be unable to attend the event and decline their invitations, a conference committee may select a Cross-Regional team in reverse CSR order.

Example: NEISA, these CSR assignments are up to date; this is for example only.

If there is an unfilled berth after it has been offered to all the teams in orange, Salve may be offered a berth. Should Salve be unable to attend, BU will be offered the next berth. At this point, the selection committee must be aware of possible teams qualified to participate in Semi's, which would exclude those teams from the RTC. Any open berths at the end of selection shall be made available for the host conference to reach out to other conferences for selection. A goal is to continue including a diverse selection from all conferences.
