Rounding the leeward mark in first, fourth, and sixth (to BU's second, third, and fifth) Navy's latter two skippers began to squeeze BU's Drusilla Saur in fifth. In the meantime, BU's Slattery and Burke worked on Navy's Gerard Coleman and eventually dropped him from first to third, while Saur managed to pass both Jasper Craig and John Speer of Navy shortly before the finish.
