2. ELIGIBILITY AND ENTRY

- 2.1. All entrants must meet ICSA eligibility requirements.
- 2.2. All sailors, coaches, and other personnel who will be at the venue must be able to provide proof of a negative COVID-19 PCR test or proof of vaccination taken within 72 hours or rapid test taken within 24 hours of the event before arrival.
- 2.3. This regatta will have an open fleet each consisting of 2 divisions, and frosh/soph fleet. Schools may enter as many teams as desired. All entrants must meet ICSA eligibility requirements. Teams shall confirm their participation via emailing **Calli Genest the host** by April 14th, 2022.

3. ENTRY FEES

- 3.1. Entry Fee is \$50 per boat and will be due by competitors meeting at 10:00 a.m. on Saturday. Each team entered is responsible for providing PCCSC-legal sails and boats. A limited number of charters are available for \$100. Please request charters by April 14th, 2022.

6. COMPETITOR'S MEETING AND SAILING INSTRUCTIONS

The competitor's meeting will be held at 10:00 a.m. on Saturday, April 23rd by on the deck

of the yacht club. The Sailing Instructions will be available prior to the competitors' meeting.

7. RACING AREA/LAUNCHING

7.1. The regatta will be sailed out of the Alamitos Bay Yacht Club. The intended racing area will be in the basin below the yacht club. Rotations will be held off the public beach down the road from the yacht club. The racing location is weather and tide permitting.

7.2. Launching will occur in two places: Alamitos Bay Yacht Club launch ramp for initial launching. The second spot will be on the public beach for rotations.

8. COACHING

All coaching should be done from the beach or yacht club deck. Any spectators on the water shall have no contact with any competitor except when rendering assistance under RRS Rule 1.1, or as instructed by the Race Committee. Coaches are not allowed on the water.

9. SCORING

Low point scoring system will be used in accordance with ICSA Procedural Rules.
