NOTICE OF RACE

1 RULES

- 1.1 The regatta will be governed by the rules as defined in *The Racing Rules of Sailing*.
- 1.2 The Intercollegiate Sailing Association (ICSA) Procedural Rules for Intercollegiate Sailing Competition and the Collegiate Dinghy Class Rules will apply.
- 1.3 The following US Sailing prescriptions will not apply: 60, 63.2, and 63.4.

2 ELIGIBILITY AND ENTRY

- 2.1 Teams will be invited to compete as follows: the defending champion; 8 MCSA teams; 1 team each from SAISA, MAISA, NEISA, and SEISA. The Chicago Yacht Club and ICSA will select additional teams to produce a total of 18 teams. Contact the ICSA intersectional regatta coordinator or the regatta chairman to be considered for entry.
- 2.2 Eligible teams may enter by registering at least 2 weeks prior to the event online through the Timme Angsten webpage of the Chicago Yacht Club website under the 'Passion-Annual Regattas' links.

3 FEES

The required fee for the regatta is \$160 per team and provides four meals (two breakfasts and two lunches) for four competitors. Additional meal packages can be purchased for \$25.

4 SCHEDULE OF EVENTS

5 FORMAT

A round robin will be sailed. Each division of each school shall sail the same boat for two races in a row, and then the other division will race the next boat in the rotation. Racing will continue until the round robin is complete or the time limit is reached, whichever occurs first.

6 HOUSING

Housing information will be provided online at the Chicago Yacht Club website on the Timme Angsten page.

7 SAILING INSTRUCTIONS

The sailing instructions will be available no later than 0730 on Saturday, November 22.

8 VENUE

The venue will be the Chicago Yacht Club Monroe Station. Races will be run inside Monroe Harbor unless the race committee directs otherwise

9 COACHING AND SUPPORT BOATS

- 9.1 Support boats will be provided by CYC. Spectators and coaches may view the races from the clubhouse and through race tracking online. Details of race tracking will be included with the registration package.
- 9.2 Coaching will not be permitted on the water.

10 COMPETITOR REQUIREMENTS

- 10.1 Each team shall bring enough clothing and equipment for four people to be properly attired for the conditions for sailing at one time, including four US Coast Guard approved (Type 3) Personal Floatation Devices (PFDs). The PFDs must be available for inspection at registration. Drysuits are strongly recommended.
- 10.2 Competitors may not compete in the Chicago Yacht Club Frostbite Series in Club 420s for two weeks prior to the Angsten.

11 PRIZES

- 11.1 The Timme Angsten Regatta Bowl will be awarded to the winning team. This perpetual trophy is maintained by the Chicago Yacht Club. A bar engraved with the year and the name of the winning college is added to the permanent Angsten plaque maintained by the Chicago Yacht Club.
- 11.2 Prizes will be awarded to the first, second and third place schools overall.
- 11.3 Prizes will be awarded to the first, second and third place schools in each division.
- 11.4 The Midwest Collegiate Sailing Association (MCSA) will award the Graduate Officers Trophy to the best placing MCSA school.
