NOTICE OF RACE

1. RULES

- 1.1. The Organizing Authority (OA) is the Pacific Coast Collegiate Sailing Conference in conjunction with host San Diego Yacht Club.
- 1.2. This regatta shall be governed by the current Racing Rules of Sailing (RRS), the prescriptions of US Sailing, ICSA Procedural Rules, ICSA Collegiate Dinghy Class Rules, PCCSC Standing Rules, and this Notice of Race, except as modified by the Sailing Instructions.
- 1.3. The right to appeal a decision of the protest committee is denied per RRS 70.5.

2. ELIGIBILITY AND ENTRY

- 2.1. All entrants must meet ICSA eligibility requirements.
- 2.2. Entry fee is \$100 per team payable online to PCCSC.
- 2.3. Teams shall confirm their participation online and with the host by 0800 the Tuesday before.

4. BOATS & EQUIPMENT

- 4.1. Collegiate FJ's will be provided for competitors, who shall not modify any boat or cause them to be modified in any way. Competitors have the option of rigging the mainsheet purchase either 3:1 or 4:1.
- 4.2. The standing rigging shall not be adjusted.

5. SAILING INSTRUCTIONS

The Sailing Instructions will be available prior to the competitors' meeting and may be posted online.

RACING AREA

The intended racing area will be the North San Diego Bay in the vicinity of the B Street Pier. Both divisions will be on the water with coaches and spares in boats.

7. SCORING
