2. RULES

This regatta shall be governed by the 2013-2016 Racing Rules of Sailing, ICSA Procedural Rules, ICSA Collegiate Dinghy Class Rules, PCCSC Standing Rules, and this Notice of Race.

3. ELIGIBILITY AND ENTRY

This regatta will be a Coed-2-Division non-rotational event. Schools may enter as many teams as desired. All entrants must meet ICSA eligibility requirements. Teams shall confirm their participation online and with the host by 0800 the Tuesday before. Entry fees must be paid to Cal Poly Sailing Team by 10:00 am competitors meeting.

4. ENTRY FEES

Entry Fees are \$25.00 per boat and will be due by competitors meeting at 10:00 a.m. on February 7th. Entry fee includes breakfast for all team members Sunday Morning. Additional Dinner tickets will be available at \$5 per person. The dinner will be held after racing on Saturday, February 7th. Please RSVP for dinner to Katie Cornella by Tuesday, February 3rd with a headcount for your team.

7. COMPETITOR'S MEETING AND SAILING INSTRUCTIONS

The competitors meeting will be held at 10:00 a.m. on Saturday, February 7th inside the gate of Morro Bay Yacht Club near the crane. The Sailing Instructions will be available prior to the competitors' meeting and posted online.

8. RACING AREA/LAUNCHING

The regatta will be sailed out of the Morro Bay Yacht Club. The intended racing area will be the north basin of Morro Bay Harbor closest to the giant rock. Rotations for A and B will be held on the beach along the north break wall. Parking is free and available next to the rock and beach area. Racing location is weather and tide permitting.

Launching will occur in two places: Morro Bay Launch ramp located on Embarcadero about 1 minute past MBYC, as well as at the MBYC crane. The launch ramp is recommended, the crane is time permitting. Trailers can be parked across the street from the yacht club in front of the larch tin shed, in the MBYC boat yard, on any streets, and on MBYC tarmac. Boats will be stored overnight on the sandspit.

9. COACHING

All coaching should be done from the beaches or dock at MBYC. Any spectators on the water shall have no contact with any competitor except when rendering assistance under RRS Rule 1.1, or as instructed by the Race Committee. Coaches are not allowed on the water.

10. SCORING

Low point scoring system will be used in accordance with ICSA Procedural Rules.

11. SATURDAY DINNER

Dinner will be held inside MBYC on Saturday, February 7th immediately after racing for all participants, guests, family, and friends. Cost is \$5 per person. Please RSVP team headcount for dinner by Tuesday, February 3rd. We do have a 120 person limit. Dinner fees will be collected by Cal Poly Sailing team at the door.

12. SUNDAY BREAKFAST

Pancake breakfast will be held at 8:30 a.m. on Sunday, February 8th. Breakfast is included with entry fees. Coffee, tea, hot chocolate, fruit and pancakes will be provided.

13. Housing

Please contact Katie Cornella if you are looking for housing. MBYC members and Cal Poly team members have generously offered to provide housing for sailors; however housing is limited.

14. DIRECTIONS

15. PARKING AND BOAT STORAGE

Parking is free everywhere surrounding yacht club but limited. There is a parking lot in front of a large tin shed, directly across from the yacht club, you may park in. Trailers can be parked in both of MBYC boat yard and launch areas over night. Boats can be stored on MBYC dock on dollies overnight.
